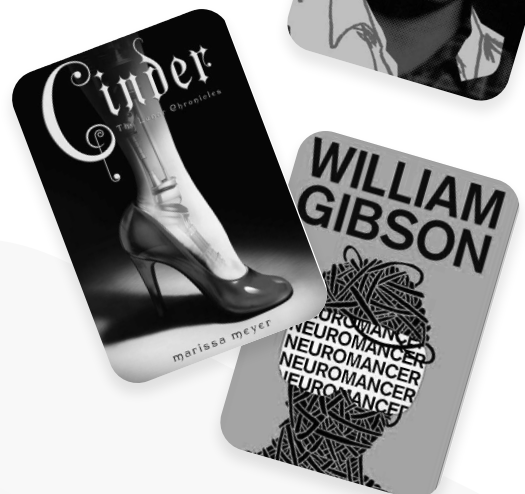
A Neal Shusterman Reading Challenge
