

Set a Community Reading Goal

- Beanstack allows educators to <u>set a community reading goal</u> that everyone in your school or district contributes to.
- Use our simple formulas to set a goal that shows progress quickly, striking a balance between achievable and ambitious:
 - School year goal = student population x 100 minutes
 - Shorter time frame goals = student population x 10 minutes per month
- Don't forget to celebrate your progress! Find <u>resources</u> for promoting your goal, like morning announcement scripts and a thermometer poster.


Our data shows that students logged double the reading minutes on Beanstack sites with a goal compared to sites without a goal.



Foster Friendly Competition

- A little friendly competition goes a long way in building a culture of reading at your school or district. Running reading challenges consistently can ignite the spirit of competition for your classroom, school, or district.
- <u>Leaderboards</u> for district and school administrators provide upto-date reading rankings so that you can run motivating reading contests at the school, grade, classroom, and individual student level.
- Our <u>templates</u> make it easy to get the word out—and Beanstack's student-facing leaderboards for friends, grades, and schools keep competition front and center.

One Beanstack analysis found that schools featured in a leaderboard boosted participation rates by eight times.



Provide Recognition and Incentives
